Welcome to EurOK Vision 2026 — a new European meeting format dedicated entirely to practical myopia control education.



With interactive workshops, expert guidance and a unique rotational format, the meeting is designed to provide practical knowledge that can be immediately applied in everyday clinical practice.


The small-group setting creates a friendly and interactive atmosphere, offering plenty of opportunity for questions, discussion and professional exchange with colleagues and experts.
